### 1. Vision and Mission

### 2. Academic Achievements

- **Class X CBSE Board Result:** 100% pass percentage.
  - 57% of students scored above 75%.
  - School Topper: **Siddhant Kansal** – 97.8%.
- **Class XII CBSE Board Result:** 94.00% pass percentage.
  - 51% students secured 75% and more.
  - School Topper: **Shreesh Agarwal** – 96.2% (Commerce Stream), **Vaidik Singhal** – 93.0% (Science Stream).
- Numerous students qualified for competitive examinations with commendable ranks.

### 3. Innovations in Teaching & Learning

This year we introduced several pedagogical innovations:

- **Blended Learning:** Integration of online and offline learning resources using Google Classroom and TataEdge Classes.
- **Project-Based Learning:** Students across grades worked on interdisciplinary projects promoting real-world problem solving.
- **Career Counseling Workshops:** Regular sessions with experts helped students explore diverse career paths.
