Dear Parents,

However, we understand that there may be instances where corrections in the school records are required. To ensure a smooth and compliant process for making such corrections, we kindly request that parents follow the guidelines outlined below:

1. Adherence to School Records for Transfer Certificates:

- Please note that the Transfer Certificate will be issued strictly in accordance with the details recorded at the time of admission. It is crucial to ensure that all information provided at the admission stage is accurate and complete.

2. Correction of Date of Birth:

- The school does not have the authority to make corrections to the date of birth in the school records without a judicial notification from a First-Class Magistrate.
- Parents seeking to correct the date of birth must obtain the necessary judicial notification and follow the prescribed protocol to have this information corrected.

3. Government Portal Data:

- Any data that has been entered and submitted on a government portal can only be altered under the direction of the respective government body.
- A formal notification from the head of the relevant government department is required, clearly instructing the school administration to make changes to the official records.

4. Name Corrections:

- Corrections or changes to a student's name will be considered only if the proper legal procedures for a name change have been followed.
- The school must receive formal communication from an authorized government official confirming that these procedures have been adhered to before any changes can be made in the school records.

Important Notes for Parents:

- Please ensure that you retain all original documents and legal notifications related to any corrections for your records and for submission to the school as required.
